



WARNINGS AND CAUTIONS

WARNING

 Shut off power at the circuit breaker or fuse panel before removing the old fixture.

PREPARATION

Before beginning installation of product, make sure all parts are present. Compare parts with package contents list and diagram above. If any part is missing or damaged, do not attempt to assemble, install or operate the product. Contact customer service for replacement parts.

PREPARATION

Your Utilitech™ incandescent light strip accent lighting is the perfect accent lighting solution for kitchens, bathrooms, bookcases, entertainment centers, and study areas. We recommend you read through the instructions entirely before starting your installation in order to help you understand all the steps and options regarding your particular installation. Unlike other accent lighting strips, your Utilitech™ accent light strips do not use foam tape for mounting. The light strips employ a unique end cap with mounting ears so it can be securely fastened to your mounting surface with the wood screws provided. This method of securement is much more reliable than foam tape which tends to de-laminate from the mounting surface after a period of time.

These accent lights are intended for under cabinet or under shelf installations ONLY.

1. DO NOT install these lights INSIDE of cabinets.

2. DO NOT attempt to install while plugged in. This lighting kit is for indoor use only and can be mounted to cabinets and surfaces having a material thickness of at least 3/8 in.

3. DO NOT mount over sinks or stoves.

4. DO NOT attempt to route the line cord through fixed

cabinets, walls, or soffits.

5. DO NOT mount these lights vertically; these lights are intended for horizontal mounting only.

Caution: Shock Hazard: DO NOT attempt to remove the clear mounting end caps on the fixture.

IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

This unit has a polarized plug (one blade is wider than the other) as a safety feature. This plug will fit in a polarized outlet only one way. If the plug does not it fully into the outlet, reverse the plug. If it still does not fit, contact a qualified electrician. Never use with an extension cord unless plug can be fully inserted. DO **NOT** attempt to defeat this feature.

SAVE THESE INSTRUCTIONS DO NOT ATTEMPT TO ASSEMBLE THIS LAMP WHILE IT PLUGGED IN. THIS LAMP IS FOR INDOOR USE ONLY.

Plan your installation prior to actually securing your lights to the mounting surface, making sure that your cord set will reach the nearest electrical outlet. DO NOT plug your cord into an electrical outlet at this time. You should only plug you cord in AFTER you have completed the installation of the switch and mounted your accent light properly.

Your Utilitech™ accent strip is a sealed unit and should NOT be opened for any reason. The bulbs are not replaceable. The bulbs are extra long life bulbs and should last approximately 20,000 hours in regular use.

- Select the location where you want to mount your light strip (A). Make sure there is sufficient room for the length of your light strip.
- 2 While holding the light strip in position, mark the location of the screws in the end cap mounting ears with a pencil or awl (Fig. 1). The screw hole locations must be exact for the fixture to mount properly.
- 3 Drill a 1/16 in. pilot hole into the marked screw locations (Fig. 2). You can also use an awl or nail to dimple the screw holes.
- 4 Screw in one of the two #8 mounting screws (B) until approximately 1/8 in. of space remains under the head of the screw (Fig. 3).
- 5 Slide one of the end cap mounting ears under the screw head. Line the other end cap mounting hole up with the pencil mark made in step 3. While holding the accent light in place, screw in the second mounting screw. Finish tightening down

both screws until the accent light strip is securely fastened to your mounting surface (Fig. 4). **DO NOT** over-tighten; fasteners will break.

6 The mounting ears allow you to swivel your strip light. You can adjust the angle of the light wand (A) by swiveling it to the proper position (Fig. 5 and Fig. 6). Make sure you have turned off






the light and allowed the fixture to cool properly before handling.

SWITCH INSTALLATION

WARNING: BEFORE BEGINNING YOUR SWITCH INSTALLATION, MAKE SURE YOUR LIGHT WAND IS UNPLUGGED.

Fixtures being plugged into a switch controlled wall outlet will not require a line switch to be installed. However, if the outlet is not switched, the line cord switch should be installed to switch the light on and off. The line switch included in the hardware kit may differ from the one in the illustrations, but it will be installed using the same basic instructions.

1 Choose a convenient, easy-to-reach location on the line cord to install the line cord switch (C). Mark the location on the smooth side of the cord. Loosen and remove the screw that holds the switch body together and once removed separate the body into halves (Fig. 1) Make sure not







the body into halves (Fig. 1). Make sure not to lose the screw and the small nut.

- 2. Decide where the switch is to be placed and make a mark on the **smooth side** of the cord using a pen or marker.
- 3 The line cord has a **ribbed side** and a **smooth side**. **DO NOT CUT THE RIBBED SIDE OF THE CORD!** A small section (1/2 in. to 5/8 in.) of cord will need to be removed on the **smooth side** of the cord. The **ribbed side** of the cord is contains a polarized wire and damaging it may result in an unsafe situation. Make the first cut near the mark drawn on the cord in Step 2 (**Fig. 2**). Make a second cut between 1/2 in. to 5/8 in. away from the first (**Fig. 3**). Peel the section between the cuts out (**Fig. 4**). **CAUTION:** do **NOT** cut or damage the insulation of the **ribbed side** of the cord.





Replace the attachment screw and nut and tighten the switch body back together (Fig. 6).

CARE AND MAINTENANCE

Your fixture is made from quality materials that will last for many, many years with minimum care. You may want to periodically clean the fixture using a mild, non-abrasive glass cleaner and soft cloth. Do **NOT** use solvents or cleaners containing abrasive agents. When cleaning the fixture, make sure you have the power turned off and do not spray liquid cleaner directly onto the bulb, socket, ballast, or wiring.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Minor problems often can be fixed without the help of an electrician. Before doing any work on the fixture, shut off power supply at the circuit breaker panel to avoid electrical shock.


