

1	Built-In Mic	For Hands-Free Conversation	
2	Mode button / ▶﴿	Mode - For Call Answer / Call End / Redial Button (In Bluetooth mode only), for searching FM stations, for changing different modes of operation between FM radio, Aux-in, Micro SD and USB. Or short press will pause or restart the music.	
3	Volume increase (V+) /▶▶	Short press will skip to the next track, or long press will increase the volume level	
4	LED button	Long press to turn on / off the Multi-Color Lights, or short press for changing different light patterns	
5	Volume decrease (V-) / ◀◀	Short press will return to the previous track, or long press will decrease the volume level	
6	USB Flash Drive slot	Plays music from USB Flash Drive (not included)	
7	Micro 5D Card slot	Plays music from Micro SD Card (not included)	
8	DC Charging Port (Micro USB Charging Port)	To charge the speaker (Charging cord included)	
9	Auxiliary Port	Plays music through Auxiliary cord (included)	
10	LED Light Indicator	Indicates the Recharging status	
11	MP3/OFF/BT power switch	MP3: Play FM or Auxiliary or Multimedia (USB Flash Drive or Micro SD Card), OFF: Switch on/off the speaker, BT: Turn on Bluetooth mode

INSTRUCTIONS FOR USE

Charging the speaker

For best results, fully charge the speaker before its first use.

- Connect the USB charging cord (included) to the DC 5V charging port of the speaker and insert the other end into a port on your computer or similar power source.
- 2.The Red LED turns on indicating that the battery is being charged. Once it is fully charged, the Red LED will turn off. it will take around 4 hours to fully charge the battery.

Note: in order to have better battery life, please do not charge for over 4 hours.

Multi-Coior Lights

- 1.By default, the Multi-Color Lights turn on, once you've turned On the speaker. If you wish to turn off the lights, long press the "LED button".
- 2.To turn On the Lights, long press the "LED button" again.
- 3. Short press the "LED button" will change different light patterns.

Turn the speaker to Biuetooth pairing mode -

- 1.Slide the "MP3/OFF/BT power switch" to BT position.
- You would hear the indication tone; the speaker is now in pairing mode.

(Note: Speaker automatically pairs with the previously paired devices)

Pairing your device with Biuetooth Speaker -

Your Bluetooth Speaker can wirelessly stream audio from any Bluetooth enabled device within the distance of 27-33 Feet. Simply follow the below steps.

- 1.Slide the "MP3/OFF/BT power switch" to BT position.
- 2.You would hear the indication tone; speaker is now in pairing mode.
- 3.Turn on the Bluetooth on your Mobile Phone or Tablet or Computer.
- 4.it will search for various devices.
- S.The pairing name of our Bluetooth Speaker is "SL RAVE", pair it with this device.
- 6.If required, enter the password '0000' to confirm to finalize pairing.
- 7.Once paired successfully, you would hear a beep tone.
 8.If you fail to pair it within the time frame or you want to pair it with a new device please follows the steps outlined above.

 Select your favorite song at the Bluetooth device and music would now stream through Bluetooth speaker.

Talking using the Bluetooth Speaker

Please ensure that your cell phone is paired with the Bluetooth Speaker to use the below functions.

Listening to Music via Bluetooth (Wireless)

Please ensure that your device (iPhone, Tablet or Other Smart Phone) is paired with the Bluetooth Speaker to stream music wirelessly. Once it is paired, play music from your device.

Increase / Decrease Volume	Playing music	Long press V+ to increase the volume or long press
Pause	Playing music	V- to decrease the volume Press ►I once to pause the music
Play	Pause	Press M once to resume the music
Skip Forward / Skip Backward	Playing music	Short press ➤ to skip forward the track. Short pres

(Note: The above functions only can be used in Bluetooth mode only. in Aux mode, you may need to control through your source device.)

Listening to FM radio

- 1. Slide the "MP3/OFF/BT power switch" to MP3 position.
- 2.it will go to FM radio function.
- Short press the Mode button for searching and recording all radio stations within frequency range 87.5-108MHz.
- 4. Press the Morido button for listening next or previous preset radio station.
- S.Long press V+ to increase the volume or long press V- to decrease the volume.

Listening to Music using AUX-In Mode

- 1.Slide the "MP3/OFF/BT power switch" to MP3 position.
- Insert the 3.5 mm Aux in cable (provided) to the Line-in jack of the speaker. And, the other end of the cable connects to the audio device (such as computer
- / tablet /etc.). 3. Select your favorite song at the source device.
- 4.Long press V+ to increase the volume or long press V- to decrease the volume.
- Listening to Music using USB Flash Drive / Micro SD Card
- 1.Slide the "MP3/OFF/BT power switch" to MP3 position.
- 2.insert SD card or USB flash drive into the USB or SD Card Slot. Music would be automatically streamed.
- 3.Press⊯or⊯to move forward or backward on your playlist.
- 4.Long press V+ to increase the volume or long press V- to decrease the volume.
- 5. Short press ► to Piay or Pause a track.

Tipsli

- 1.Press the "Mode button" to switch different functions of the speaker between -FM radio / AUX-in / SD-USB.
- When the unit is not in use, turn OFF the device to save the battery power.

Do's and Don'ts

Do not play music at excessive levels. Damage to hearing and/or equipment may resuit.

Do not use outdoors in wet or in damp surroundings.

Troubleshooting

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Low sound level	Source (Tablet, Mobile Phone, Laptop, etc.) volume too low. Battery dead	Adjust source volume. Charge Battery.
Sound distorted	Battery nearly dead	Charge Battery
No sound at all.	Source (Tablet, Mobile Phone, Laptop.) turned off.	Turn the source on.
	Speaker turned off.	Turn the speaker on.
	Volume turned down source.	Adjust volume source
	Media paused on source.	Play media from source.
