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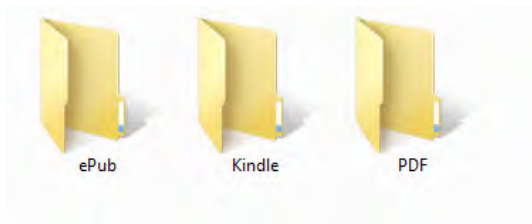
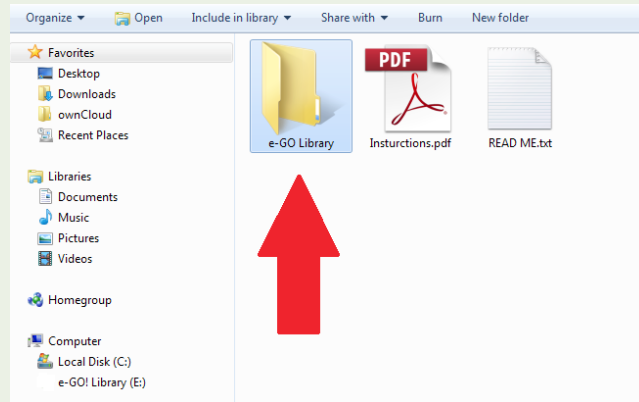
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Prologue: The Basics

This introductory section covers basic information about the contents of your **e-GO! Library** flash drive and how to choose the correct file format for the device you will use to read these books.

When you open the **e-GO! Library** (refer to the following tutorial under Section 1 of this guide for instructions), you should see contents similar, but perhaps not identical, to these:



The main folder is **e-GO! Library**, which contains all 1,250 books of the library. Click on this folder to open it.

The **e-GO! Library** folder is organized into three subfolders: **ePub**, **Kindle**, and **PDF**, which represent the three formats available for each book.

The format you should choose will depend on which device/system you intend to use to read your books. Here is a breakdown of the three formats (you will find more detailed descriptions of these formats on the next page):

PDF	ePub	Kindle

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Kindle

The Kindle format (.mobi) is specifically for use with the Amazon Kindle reading devices or Amazon Kindle apps.

Kindle devices are available from Amazon (amazon.com). Alternatively, *Kindle apps may be downloaded and installed on other devices such as computers, tablets and smartphones. You may download Kindle apps through this web link: [Click Here](#)

****Recent reports indicate the Amazon Kindle apps are no longer functioning well on Android devices. If you are using an Android device, we recommend you use the ePub formatted books in conjunction with the Google Play Books app.***

ePub

The ePub format is the primary one used for most mobile devices, such as eReaders, tablets and smartphones. The devices that prefer the ePub format include, but are not limited to, the following:

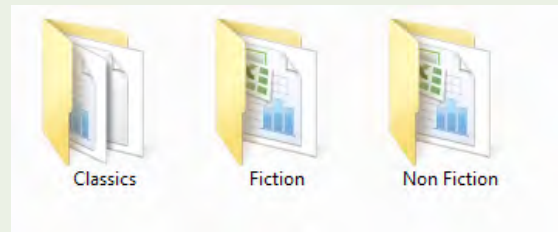
- iPad, iPhone, and iPod Touch
- Android devices, including Samsung Galaxy phones and tablets
- NOOK
- Kobo Reader
- Nearly all eReaders other than Kindle

PDF

The PDF format is typically best for reading on the computer itself. For computer reading, we recommend using the Adobe PDF Reader, which you can download free from this link: [Click Here](#)

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Once you have determined which format to use, **Kindle**, **ePub**, or **PDF**, click on that folder. Within each of these format folders, you will see three subfolders: **Classics**, **Fiction**, and **Non-Fiction**. The **e-Go! Library** contains 1,250 books: The **Classics** folder contains 250 books; **Fiction** contains 650 books; and **Non-Fiction** contains 350 books.

Each of the three main sections – Classics, Fiction and Non-Fiction – is further subdivided into book categories. For example, if you click on the Classics folder you will see that it contains a number of category subfolders, as in the image to the left. This subfolder also includes an Excel Index which lists and describes all the books included within the Classics section:

Click on one of the subfolders – Drama, for example. You will now see all books categorized as Drama within the Classics section. In this example, we selected the PDF format earlier, so these titles all have .pdf extensions. If you have a PDF reader and select one of these titles, the book should now open for you.

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Indexes

Each of the three sections – **Classics**, **Fiction**, and **Non-Fiction** – also contain Indexes which list by category all titles included within that section.

The Indexes are Excel documents and require a program that can open/read Excel documents. If you do not have one installed, you may download a free Excel viewer online through this link: [Click Here](#)

From the list of folders presented, navigate to the **ePub** folder you pasted in Step 8 above and click on it. Select one of the three folders – Classics, Fiction, or Non-Fiction – and then the desired category within the folder. Click on a title that interests you, and it should begin to load into the **Play Books** app.

Note: It might take time for the book to load. While loading, the book can be found under the **Uploads** portion of the **Play Books** app. ~ Enjoy!

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6.4 Transfer from Windows 10 PC to an Android Device

This tutorial explains how to transfer the **e-GO! Library** books from your computer running **Windows 10** to your Android device using a USB cable.

Important: First, be sure you have saved a copy of your **e-GO! Library** to your computer. If you need further instructions on how to do this or experience some problems, please check out our **to Computer (Windows 10) from USB** tutorial.

Note: There are many Android devices in use, and there are many versions of Android itself. The following tutorial is a general guide. Your actual experience and results may slightly vary depending on your device and the Android version you use. This tutorial was created using 6.0.1 Android version and Nexus 7 tablet.

Note: **Google Play Books** (Android) uses the **ePub** format.

Important: Before you start transferring your books to Android device, please make sure your device has the **Google Play Books** app installed. If it doesn't, go to the Google Play Store from the device itself and download the Play Books app (free). If you already have the **Play Books** app on your device, skip this step.

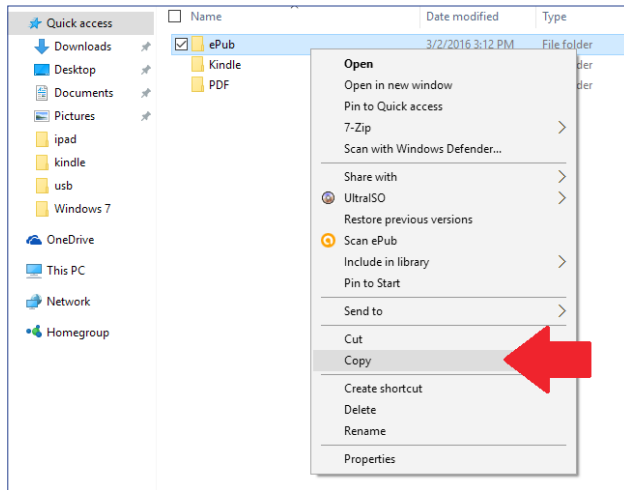


Step 1

Navigate to where you have stored your **e-GO! Library** folder on your computer. If you need instructions on how to do this, see our **to Computer (Windows 10) from USB** tutorial first. This tutorial assumes the **e-GO! Library** has been saved to the Desktop. Open this folder.

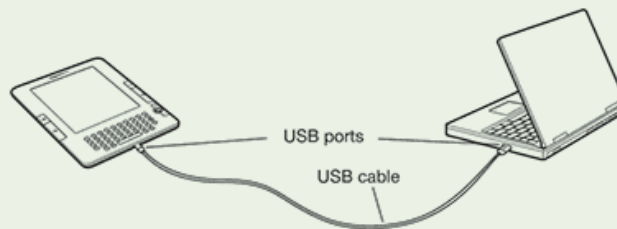


Step 2

Within the **e-GO! Library** folder you will see three subfolders: ePub, Kindle, and PDF. Right-click on the **ePub** folder and then select (left-click) **Copy**. This will copy the entire **e-GO! Library**. However, if you want to copy only certain books, see the next optional step.

Optional: If you wish to copy only certain books or sections of the **e-GO! Library**, open (left-click) the **ePub** folder like in Step 2 above; then, navigate to the section or individual books and select only those you want and left-click **Copy**.

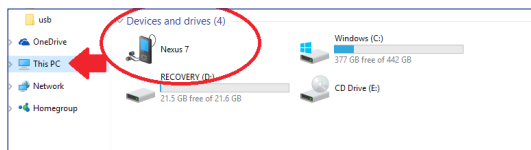
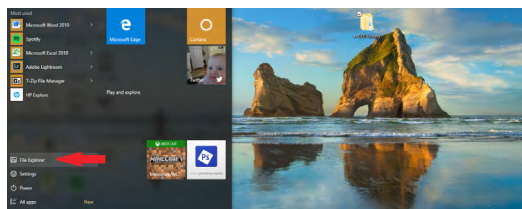
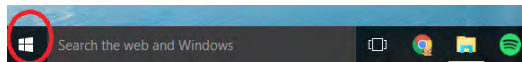
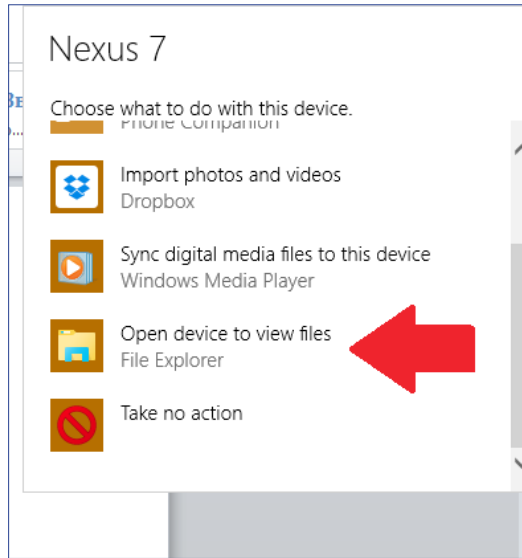
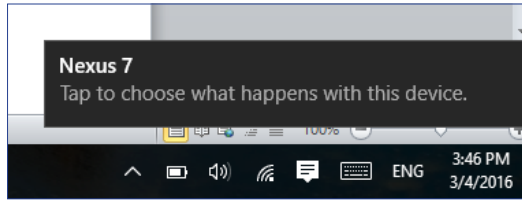


Step 3

Make sure your device is turned **ON**. Connect your Android device to your computer's USB port using a **USB** cable.

Option A. Tap the banner showed to the left and scroll to the option **Open device to view files.**

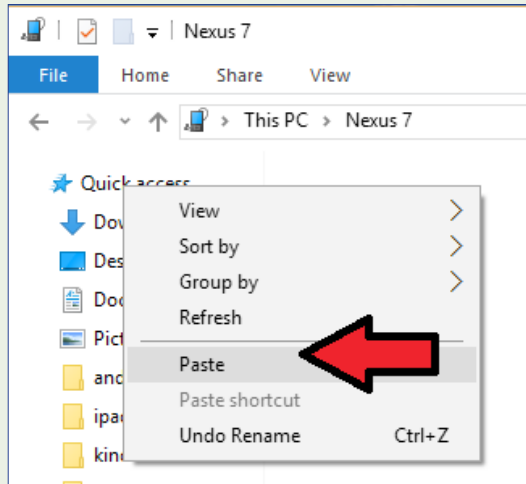
Option B. Click the **Start** menu icon.

Select **File Explorer** from the Start menu.

Choose **This PC**. Your device should appear under **Portable Devices**. Click on it. **Note:** Your device might not appear exactly as shown to the left, but you should be able to identify it.

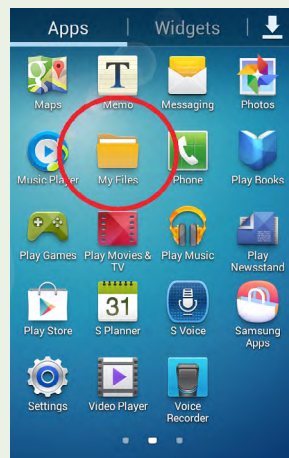
When you open your device, you should see several folders. Right-click on empty space between the folders and then select **Paste**. This should paste the **ePub** folder you copied in step 2 above (or specific books you selected) to your device.

Eject or disconnect your device from your computer.

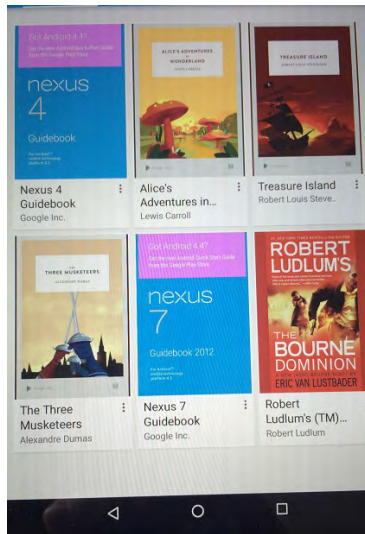
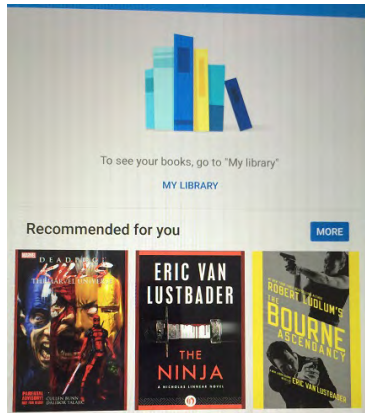

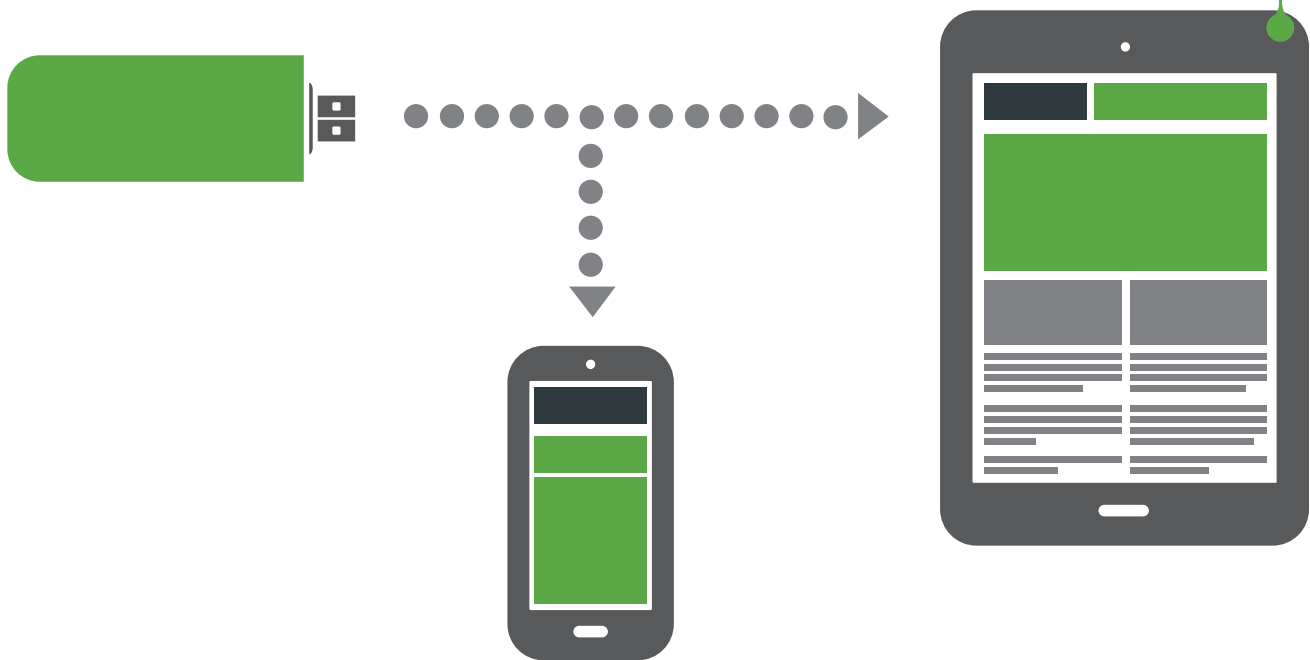
Scroll the list of folders until you find the **ePub folder** you pasted in step 5 above and click on it. Select either the Classics, Fiction or Non-Fiction folders, then navigate to the appropriate category. Once you find a book you like, click on its title and it should begin to load in the Play Books app.

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7.1 Transfer to an Android Device Using a Micro USB

This tutorial explains how to use the **micro USB end** of your *e-GO! Library* flash drive to transfer its contents directly to an Android device.

Important: Your Android device must have a Micro USB port for this method of transfer to work. If it does not, consult our Section 6 tutorials, ***Transfer from Computer (Windows 7, 8 or Mac) to Android***.

Note: There are many devices in use running Android, and there are many versions of Android itself. The following tutorial is a general guide. Your actual experience and results might vary depending on the device model and the Android version being used.

Important: Be sure your device has the **Google Play Books** app installed. If it does not, navigate to the Google Play Store from the device itself and download **Play Books** (free). If you already have **Play Books**, you can skip this step.

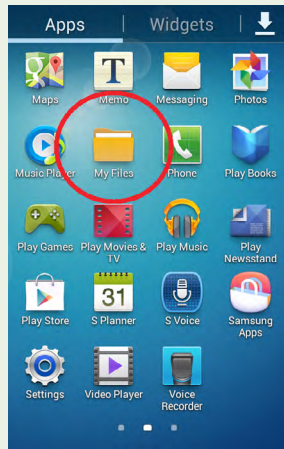


Step 1

First, insert the *e-GO! Library* Micro USB end into your device's Micro USB port.

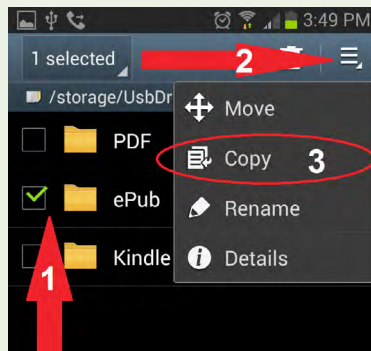
From your device, navigate to where files and folders are kept. Most (but not all) devices have an icon labeled **My Files**. If so, click on this icon.

Select the **All Files** option from the list presented; then the **UsbDrive** option; and then click on the **e-GO! Library** folder.

Check the box next to the **ePUB** folder option; then hit the **Menu** icon and select **Copy**.

Step 5

Your device should have backtracked a step and taken you to storage location options. Select **sdCard** (or another folder on your device where you want to save the **e-GO! Library** contents); then select the **Paste Here** option. These actions will copy all the eBooks from the **e-GO! Library** flash drive in the ePub format to your device's memory. You will be able to read the books without having the **e-GO! Library** connected.

Step 6

After all files are copied, select the **ePub** folder from the list presented.

Step 7

From the **ePub** folder you can browse selections starting with the main folders: Classics, Fiction, and Non-Fiction. Click on one of those three folders and then on a category that interests you from within that folder. For example, click **Classics** and then **Drama**.

Step 8

Here you will see all the books listed in that category. Click on a title that interests you. Following the example of Classics > Drama from above, you might click on “A Bit O’ Love.epub.”

Step 9

The title you selected should open in the **Play Books** app. **Note:** It might take time for the book to load. While loading, the book can be found under the **Uploads** portion of the **Play Books** app. ~ Enj@y!
